Each speaker is allowed to give only one lecture. The time limit for each lecture is 15 minutes plus 5 minutes for discussion. The number of papers is limited to two per author.

Each lecture room will be equipped with a computer and a projector. Overhead transparency projectors will also be provided. Presentations should be prepared in PowerPoint or Adobe PDF format.

Proceedings

The proceedings of the Conference will be published after the reviewing process and sent to all the participants. Papers containing original research written in English of no more than 8 pages should be sent to Editors by October 31, 2009. Only presented papers will be considered for publication.

The proceedings in section "Teaching of mathematics and computer science" will be published as a special volume of the "Pedagoška stvarnost" journal.
